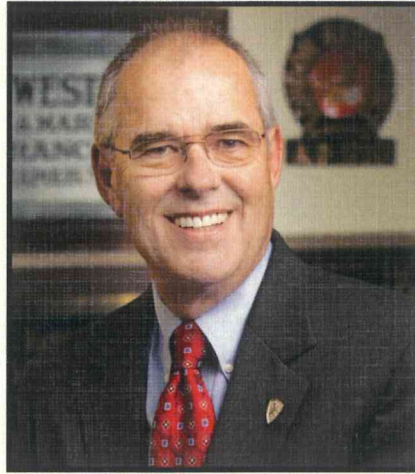


# *The Mitchell Stallings Memorial Award*
